



2,964 beggars detained in Lahore

Australia announces \$74m package to Ukraine

(Agencies): Australia, one of the biggest non-NATO contributors to Ukraine, is to send an additional 70 military vehicles to Ukraine as part of its latest military assistance package for the country. Prime Minister Anthony Albanese announced the 110 million Australian dollars (\$73.5m) package on Monday and told reporters the plan had been under consideration before the weekend's tumult in Russia.

The package will include 28 M113 armoured vehicles, 14 special operations vehicles, 28 medium trucks and 14 trailers as well as an additional supply of 105mm artillery ammunition. "Australia is unwavering in our resolve to condemn and oppose Russia's actions and to help Jkraine achieve victory, Albanese said. Defence Minister Richard Marles said he was "proud" of the additional support Australia was offering. "We expect this to be a protracted conflict, and so we will stand with Ukraine for as long as it takes," he told reporters. The package, which did not include the Hawkei light of a huge increase in recent armoured patrol vehicles or more Bushmaster infantry vehicles requested by Kyiv, comes as Ukraine continues a counteroffensive to push Russian forces from areas they have occupied in the east of the country Serhiy Cherevatyi, spokesperson for Ukraine's eastern military command, said the military advanced at least 600 metres (1,970 ft) over the previous day near Bakhmut, a city taken by Wagner forces in May after months of fighting. The Russian defence ministry said there had been at least 10 attacks in that area, which they repelled.

FREETOWN (Agencies): Police in Sierra Leone have fired tear gas at the main opposition party's headquarters in the capital Freetown as voters await the results of a fiercely fought general election. The opposition's presidential candidate Samura Kamara of All People's Congress (APC) said on Twitter that live bullets had been fired at his office inside the party headquar-

Reuters agency also reported that one person - a woman - was found severely wounded and without a pulse at the opposition party headquarters. Yvonne Aki-Sawyerr, a prominent APC member bidding for a second term as Freetown mayor, tweeted photos from inside the building showing people taking cover on the floor. "I am in the APC Party office and we are under fire," she wrote. In a statement, police said members of the APC had paraded through Freetown, "announcing to the public that they had won the election. They attracted "a huge crowd" of supporters outside the headquarters, who "started harassing passers-by", the

US officials see weakened Putin

WASHINGTON cies): The unprecedented challenge to President Vladimir Putin by Wagner Group fighters has exposed "cracks" in the strength of his leadership that may take weeks or months to play out, US Secretary of State Antony Blinken has said, as Russia ally China says it supports Moscow in "protecting national stability". In a series of television interviews, Blinken and members of the United States in ways that could aid Ukraine's counteroffensive against Russian forces within its territory while benefitting Russia's neighbours, including Poland and the Baltic states.

"I don't think we've seen

the final act," Blinken said on ABC's This Week news programme after an aborted mutiny by forces led by Wagner Group founder Yevgeny Prigozhin. Blinken said tensions that sparked the action had been growing for months and added the threat of "internal matter" could affect Moscow's military capabilities in Ukraine. "We've seen more cracks emerge in the Russian façade. It is too soon to tell exactly where they go, and when they get there. But certainly, we have all sorts of new questions that Putin is going to have to address in the weeks and months ahead," Blinken said. US officials expect to learn more soon about the events that unfolded in Russia, including details of the deal with Prigozhin mediated by Belarusian Alexander Lukashenko that led Wagner fighters to return to their bases. Forces led by Prigozhin, a former Putin ally and ex-convict, have fought the bloodiest of battles in Russia's 16-month war in Ukraine. Meanwhile, China - which has maintained close ties with Putin since the Ukraine operation was launched - called the revolt an "internal affair" and expressed support for Putin's government.

This came after China's Foreign Minister Qin Gang Russia's met Foreign Minister Andrey Rudenko in According to Al Jazeera's Shapovalova, Yulia Russians are continuing to support Putin as "he controlled the situation" but "many admit the mutiny has dealt a blow to President Putin's reputation". "Others say that Prigozhin is obviously a player in Vladimir Putin's political system and all he has - the funds, human resources, all the weapons all that comes from the state and he totally depends on Vladimir Putin, despite his rivalry with the Ministry of Shapovalova Defence," said, reporting Moscow.

FATA merger and intent of tribesmen

Minister for Communication, Asad Mehmood has urged the government to thoroughly review the merger of the Federally Administered Tribal Areas (FATA) in light of the ongoing challenges faced by the region. Speaking on the floor of the National Assembly, the Federal Minister emphasized the need to ascertain the desires of the people of FATA through a referendum and stressed government officials personally visit the area and assess the ground realities to gain a comprehensive understanding. Minister was of the view that although FATA has progressed however firsthand information is vital to assess the nature and volume of problems faced by the people in most disadvantaged regions in the country.

The newly merged districts of KP, formerly known as Federally Administrated Tribal Areas (FATA) had met a hapless fate since the creation of the country. The people of the area were largely ignored by the past governments because of its far-flung geographical location, and peculiar governance system under British rule coupled with tribal customs and traditions. Undoubtedly, the people of the erstwhile FATA (Federal Administered Tribal Area) had faced multiple economic, social, and law and order issues for the past seven decades, due to the absence of a regular political and governance system in the region. All successive governments shed away from their responsibility throughout history rather this most improvised region was used as a base camp during the Afghan jihad in the 1980s. Later, this ungoverned region served as a terrorism hub in the early 21st century and tribesmen suffered utmost hardship and cruelties at the hands of terrorists and endured losses in the wake of the Counterterrorism operations of the Security

After clearing of erstwhile FATA from miscreants and terrorist infrastructure through the successful operation Zarb-e-Azb, the government of Pakistan moved toward mainstreaming FATA in November 2015 by constituting a FATA Reforms Committee, while subsequently, various legislative, administrative, and fiscal measures were adopted to merge the region in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province in the follow ing years. The federal government has approved an annual 3% share under the Federal Divisible Pool of the NFC award to implement a 10 years development plan to bring the backward region at par with the rest of the country. Unfortunately, the FATA merger could not resolve the problems of local tribesmen and their issues persisted in one or the other way. There are continuous complaints regarding the no-disbursement of a 3% share to implement the FATA development plan and multiple development projects face delays in their completion, while the absence of essential government infrastructure, educational, and health facilities as well as the re-emergence of terrorists groups in the area cast serious concerns among the masses regarding the future of their coming generations.

A large faction of the FATA population intends to maintain a separate identity and oppose the FATA merger into the KP. Local Tribesmen wanted to remain intact with their culture, and elders are desirous of playing a role in administrative and judicial affairs through the jirga system. Multiple petitions have been filed in the Supreme Court seeking the annulment of the FATA merger and requesting the creation of a new province. Meanwhile, local political and ethnic groups fear the continuation of their economic discrimination and resource exploitation in the case of the FATA merger with Peshawar. At the time, thousands of Afghan refugees have illegally procured Pakistani Identity Cards and are residing in Erstwhile FATA while hundreds of Pakistani tribesmen are living across the Pak-Afghan borders. Apparently, those issues would be further complicated if not handled carefully in consultation with the local leaders and tribal

The Federal government and national institutions must calibrate consciously and resolve this issue amicably according to the need and desires of the people of Erstwhile FATA as our enemies across the Pak-Afghan border and the other side of Wagha are equally ready to exploit the situation and subvert patriotic tribesmen against the country through agents provocateur and local anti-state groups. At times, an important and delicate responsibility rests with the Political leadership to consider the genuine need of their people and work toward that end.

The future leaders of Russia must be individuals who feel emotional and mental anguish when faced with decisions that may lead to even a single death, even if they believe it serves the greater good.

Khodorkovsky's support for Prigozhin's "march of justice" raises significant concerns and invites scrutiny. While the Russian opposition's reactions to this weekend's events differ, Khodorkovsky's appears to be driven by opportunism, as he seeks to secure influence within a revolutionary movement that may shape the future of Russia. Furthermore, his endorsement of Prigozhin contradicts historical patterns of regime change and poses ethical dilemmas. As the situation continues to evolve, it is vital to critically analyze the motivations and implications of such alliances, especially now that it seems that the revolution has been delayed. Since Prigozhin's stand-down, Khodorkovsky's stance has become more concrete. He envisions that the only rebellion capable of overthrowing Putin's regime is one that uses force. Yet he suggests that those with the guns in their hands should somehow not be given power. It remains to be seen how one achieves that.

Churchill's famous description of Russia as 'a riddle, wrapped in a mystery, inside an enigsummarises what many Russia analysts feel after the aborted armed rebellion led by Wagner commander Yevgeny Prigozhin this weekend. While answers remain elusive, some elements seem important to help

navigate through the fog. There are powerful arguments that Vladimir Putin has been weakened by Prigozhin's armed rebellion. For the first time in 23 years, many Russians will have woken up on Saturday morning wondering whether their president was still in control. Then, hours after a visibly shaken Putin announced that traitors would be punished, charges against Prigozhin were dropped, and his armed men, who allegedly shot down a transport plane and at least two helicopters (the exact number is still unconfirmed), killing a number of highly skilled military pilots, were given security guarantees. This indicates that Putin had to make concessions to Prigozhin, and in a country where a social media post criticising the army carries a potential prison sentence, the gap between the rich and powerful and ordinary citizens has been unashamedly confirmed in full public view. The Russian army, which has stagnated on the Ukrainian front for months, was unable - or unwilling to stop Wagner's advance through swathes of Russian

territory. Putin's unspoken contract with the Russian people is that in exchange for democratic freedoms he gives them stability and security. This contract has been broken. In a democracy all of the above would spell political death. But Russia is neither a democracy nor a functioning state. The only way to make sense of what happened in the past few days is to view events through the prism of a feud between criminal gangs in which each mafia boss holds so much leverage over the other that the balance of power can easily tip either way.

The events of the past two days have certainly caused a lot of alarm in the Kremlin. First, Putin faced a highprofile figure who controls his own militia and openly rebelled against him. Second, the mercenary forces marched with ease into Rostov-on-Don and then reached within a few tussian territory. This weakness was also revealed in late May and early June when a combat group consisting of the "Russian Volunteer Corps" and "Freedom of Russia Legion", two Russian volunteer factions, started launching attacks on Russia's Belgorod region. They even manan attempt to create a demilitarised zone. This brazen act sparked outrage among many Russian politicians and media experts, who clamoured for immediate retaliation. Yet Putin remained conspicuously silent on the matter. This uncharacteristic reticence left even his most loyal supporters puzzled; some voiced their confusion on state TV, questioning the lack of a clear plan and echoing the call for retribution. Kipchoge sets sights on Olympic marathon treble

KAPTAGAT (AFP/APP): Two months on from his disappointing perform-ance at the Boston marathon, Kipchoge tells AFP he is determined to keep on writing history --and secure a third Olympic marathon crown next year. The Kenyan widely regarded as the greatest marathon runner of all time has set himself many challenges in his dazzling career, and insatiable remains Olympic titles, his world record of 2:01:09 in Berlin in 2022 and an incredible wins in 18 marathons he has entered. He broke the mythical two-hour barrier over the 26.2 mile (42.195 kilometre) distance in Vienna in 2019, with a time of 1:59:40, but the feat was not recognised as an official world record as it was not in competition. Victory has eluded the 38-year-old in the Boston and New York marathons, which if he won would make him the first man to have all six major titles under his belt. "The priority now is to focus on the Olympics and win a third time. The other (challenges) will come later," Kipchoge says in an interview with AFP at the

Private companies start extracting marble mine

BGHLAN (Khaama Press): The Ministry of Mines and Petroleum has signed a fiveyear contract to extract marble from a mine in the Khwaja Zaid Valley of the Doshi district of Baghlan province with two companies.

The Department of Mines representative stated that this mine has two blocks, and the firms will pay the government 900 Afghanis each tonne. According to the governor of Baghlan, the extraction of this mine will assist the local population by enhancing infrastructure and generating employment.

Operations are now regulated, and according to Adel, a representative of Baghlan Mining Directorate, "With smallscale companies, each of them has a contract for five years, and these companies start their work according to the plan and contract that was concluded.' In response, the gover-

nor of Baghlan stated that funds from the province's mines would be used for infrastructural initiatives such as constructing and maintaining roads, bridges, and culverts. 'We assure the people

that the work will be done safely and properly in this mine, and we assure the people that public services will be provided to them, said Mawlawi Abdul Rahman Haqqani, governor of Baghlan province.

Israel approves plans for illegal settlement homes

WEST BANK (Agencies): Israel's far-right government has approved plans to build thousands of new homes in illegal Israeli settlements in the occupied West Bank, in a move that a Palestinian official decried as part of an "open war against the Palestinian people". The decision comes amid rising violence in the occupied territory and growing United States criticism of Israel's settlement policies.

The Defence Ministry planning committee that oversees settlement construction approved more than 5,000 new settlement homes on Monday. The units are at various stages of planning, and it was not immediately clear when construction would begin. There was no immediate comment from the ministry. The international community, along with the Palestinians, considers settlement construction illegal and an obstacle to peace. More than 700,000 Israelis live in the occupied West Bank and East Jerusalem – territories captured by Israel in 1967 and sought by the Palestinians for a

future state. "The Netanyahu government is moving forward with its aggression and open war against the Palestinian people," said Wasel Abu Yousef, a Palestinian official in the West Bank. "We affirm that all settler colonialism in all the occupied Palestinian territories is illegitimate and illegal." Israel's government, which took office in late December, is dominated by religious and ultranationalist politicians with close ties to the settlement movement. Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich, a firebrand settler leader, has been granted Cabinet-level authority over settlement policies and has vowed to double the settler population in the occupied West Bank.

Al Jazeera's Imran Khan, reporting from the Giv'at Ze'ev settlement in the occupied West Bank, said the news was "a very big victory for Bezalel Smotrich". "Normally, to approve settlement expansion, there are six phases. They included things like security considerations, who was going to actually build the settlement, political considerations. At each of those stages, MKs members of parliament [the Knesset] - and the international community could voice their concerns and often they would be slowed down," Khan said.

"But last week the cabinet, led by Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, streamlined that process completely and handed over almost complete control to Bezalel Smotrich. He's exercised that control today." Netanyahu's government has made settlement expansion its top priority since he was re-elected in November.

Khan said 900 new buildings had been approved for construction in the illegal Giv'at Ze'ev settlement. "That is going to make this an even more permanent place than it already is," Khan said. At least 174 Palestinians have been killed by Israeli forces and settlers since the start of this year, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health. Some 24 people have been killed in Palestinian attacks.

Israel captured the West Bank, east Jerusalem and the Gaza Strip in the 1967 Middle East war. The Palestinians claim all three territories for a future independent state. United Nations Special Rapporteur on Palestine Francesca Albanese told Al Jazeera that international law has "a problem of enforcement". "There is a problem of double standards, because clearly when it comes to Palestine there is a cognitive dissonance especially among Western countries and reticence in applying the coercive measures and all the prohibitions that international law affords," Albanese

He said that the PML-N vice president and chief organizer Maryam Nawaz and Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl (JUI-F) chief Fazlur Rehman have undermined the authority of the courts through their speeches and rallies. "Their answers and speeches in rallies are in themselves contempt of court," Aitzaz Ahsan said. The senior lawyer further stated that the Supreme Court should disqualify the politicians found guilty in contempt of court.
